Definitions

MFN Messe Friedrichshafen GmbH shall hereafter be referred to as "MFN".

OSC Exhibitors receive their login data for the Messe Friedrichshafen Online Service Center (hereafter referred to as "OSC") upon stand allocation. Media features as well as technical and organizational orders must be executed via the OSC.

General event information

1. Opening times

The HAM RADIO 2026 will take place from Friday, June 26 to Sunday, June 28, 2026, at the MFN exhibition grounds in Friedrichshafen. The exhibition is open Friday through Saturday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The right to alter the opening times due to serious reasons is reserved. Changes will be announced in good time. <u>Access for exhibitors:</u> one hour before start of the exhibition and one hour after the end of the exhibition.

2. Set-up and dismantling times

2.1 Set-up

Wednesday, June 24, 2026 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. Thursday, June 25, 2026 7 a.m. - 10 p.m.

Advanced stand set-up must be approved by the project management and is subject to charge. It can be ordered via OSC.

2.2 Dismantling

Sunday, June 28, 2026 3 p.m. - 10 p.m. Monday, June 29, 2026 7 a.m. - 6 p.m.

Early dismantling is not permitted. In case of non-compliance, MFN reserves the right to impose sanctions. Please note the MFN General Conditions of Participation (www.messe-friedrichshafen.com/exhibiting-quidelines).

2.3 Additional deadlines

<u>Early bird discount</u> (5 % discount on net stand rental fee) for applications by January 31, 2026, at the latest.

3. Registration and admission

Registration for HAM RADIO 2026 is made by using the online registration portal. With this intention to exhibit, the company declares to MFN its sincere interest to participate as an exhibitor. The submission of the online registration form does not constitute a claim to admission.

MFN shall submit a written placement proposal to the exhibitor, which shall require the written consent of the exhibitor within the response time set for him. The exhibitor's acceptance of the placement constitutes the contractual offer, from which the exhibitor can no longer withdraw once it has been received by MFN.

The contract with MFN for participation shall only be concluded upon confirmation of participation by MFN, which constitutes acceptance of the contract. By sending the placement agreement, which does not yet constitute a claim to participation, the exhibitor accepts the Special and General Terms and Conditions of Participation, the Technical Guidelines, the House Rules, the Data Protection Guidelines as well as all further conditions of participation listed at https://www.hamradio-friedrichshafen.com/exhibit/become-an-exhibitor.

4. Participation fee/ Exhibitor passes, Co-Exhibitors

- **4.1** The **participation fee** includes the provision of the floor space, a certain number of exhibitor passes, exhibitor service by the project management, provision of the exhibition's in-house information systems, target group specific marketing, hall security, cleaning of the halls and complimentary promotional material for the exhibitor's own visitor advertising.
- **4.2** The number of exhibitor passes included in the participation fee is based on the stand size. The exact number of passes due can be found in the participation invoice.
- **4.3.** The **co-exhibitor fee** is € 160.00 / co-exhibiting company. Definition of co-exhibitor: see General Conditions of Participation. Co-exhibitors shall receive 2 exhibitor badges free of charge.

5. Terms of payment

The participation fee is due immediately upon receipt of the admission invoice without any deduction; this also applies to all further invoices from MFN. The payment terms on MFN's invoices are decisive; please note the bank details.

6. Stand cancellation/ cancellation fee

If the exhibitor fails to participate after admission has been granted, the exhibitor shall be obliged to pay a fee. Withdrawal from the application is possible free of charge until admission. After admission, withdrawal is subject to the following costs: 100 % of the participation fee. Stands that are not occupied by June 25, 2026, 6:00 p.m. may be reallocated by the exhibition management at short notice.

7. Stand construction requirements

The general stand height is 3.50 m. Stands that exceed the standard construction height of 3.50 m or are special constructions must be submitted to the project management for approval by means of a dimensioned plan up to 4 weeks before the start of construction. Ceiling suspensions also require approval. Further details on stand construction are available online in the Technical Guidelines: www.messe-friedrichshafen.com/exhibiting-guidelines.

8. Sales Regulations

All offered products and services must be declared with price tag. The prices must include German VAT and all additional costs. The European WEEE guidelines must be considered.

9. WiFi

MFN has its own WiFi, which exhibitors and visitors can log onto free of charge. Exhibitor's own WiFi must be registered and comply with specific conditions. Registration and prerequisites can be accessed via the OSC.

10. Use of operations equipment

For logistical and safety reasons, the use of cranes, forklifts and lifting platforms/ hydra ladders is exclusively limited to the official contract partners of MFN. These services can be ordered via the OSC.

11. Guarding/Liability

MFN does not assume any obligation to exercise proper care of exhibits, stand fittings and objects which are the property of the stand personal or the exhibitors. Stand guarding can be ordered via the OSC.

12. Use of Music/ GEMA

Exhibitors must register the use of copyright music, videos, or movies with the German authority GEMA. Registration forms are available at: www.messe-friedrichshafen.com/exhibiting-guidelines

Please note that even GEMA-free music must be registered!

If the music is actually GEMA-free, GEMA will not issue an invoice or will cancel the invoice. Further details and the corresponding registration process can be found here: GEMA Registration

13. Deposit regulations

A deposit of \in 50.00 for cars and trailers and \in 100.00 for trucks will be charged upon entry to the exhibition grounds during set-up. This will be refunded if the vehicles leave the exhibition grounds in good time. During the event, a deposit will also be charged when entering the exhibition grounds without a parking ticket.

14. Floor Covering

The hall floor is made of rare asphalt. Color defects are possible (re-coloring is not possible). The use for floor covering is recommended.

15. Additional services

In addition to the participation fee, the acceptance of the following services is obligatory:

- Fee for general waste disposal: € 1.50 / sgm stand space, maximum € 75.00
- The AUMA fee of € 0.60 / sqm to be paid by the exhibitor will be invoiced by MFN for the AUMA and passed on (see General Conditions of Participation)
- Energy fee: 49,56€
- All exhibitors will be included in a printed version of the index of exhibitors as well on the website of the HAM RADIO. An entry will be made in the alphabetical directory with information about the exhibitor's offerings. A media fee of € 95.00 will be charged for the mandatory entry in the exhibitor's directory. The entry can be edited in advance by the exhibitor in the OSC. The deadline for the close of editing will be announced with the notification of the OSC login data.

Additional services can be ordered via the OSC.

16. Pricing/ Reverse-Charge-Procedure

All quoted prices are net prices. If the statutory VAT applies, it will be invoiced in addition. Please note concerning this the explanations of the reverse charge procedure and the VAT identification number in the General Conditions of Participation.

17. Reservations, force majeure, cancellation, and other changes to the event

Unforeseen events, in particular cases of force majeure (for example natural disasters, war, terror, failure, or massive disruptions in traffic and/or communication links, as well as special epidemic risks when contagious diseases occur) which make it impossible or irresponsible to hold the event as planned, entitle MFN to postpone, shorten and extend an event, to completely cancel its opening and to close an already started event temporarily, finally, in individual parts or in total. 18. Legal notices

Serious violations of the exhibition terms and conditions give MFN the right to close stands immediately and to clear them off without requiring court action. This applies to cases of advertising in contravention and in case of advertising for political or ideological purposes.
